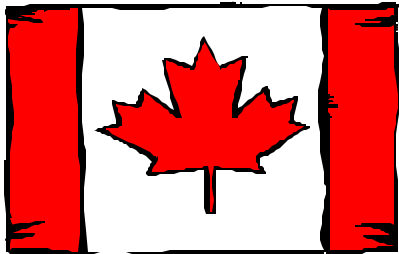


It's Time for Family Camp!
